Old Testament verses that contain the phrase “the last days”

And Jacob called unto his sons, and said, “Gather yourselves together, that I may tell you *that* which shall befall you in **the last days**.” (Genesis 49:1, emphasis added)

And it shall come to pass in **the last days** *that* the mountain (kingdom) of Yahweh’s house shall be established in the top of the mountains (kingdoms), and shall be exalted above the hills (little kingdoms); and all gentiles shall flow unto it. (Isaiah 2:2, the mountain of Yahweh’s house is the New Testament kingdom of Yahweh, emphasis added)

But in **the last days** it shall come to pass, *that* the mountain (kingdom) of the house of Yahweh shall be established in the top of the mountains (kingdoms), and it shall be exalted above the hills (little kingdoms); and people shall flow unto it. (Micah 4:1, emphasis added)

And now, behold, I go unto my people (): come *therefore*, and I will advise you what this people (Israel) shall do to your people (Moabites) in **the last days**. (Numbers 24:14, emphasis added)

When you art in tribulation, and all these things are come upon you, *even* in **the last days**, if you turn to Yahweh your God, and shall be obedient unto his voice; ...He will not forsake you, neither destroy you...(Deuteronomy 4:30, emphasis added)

For I know that after my death you will utterly corrupt *yourselves*, and turn aside from the way which I have commanded you; and evil will befall you in **the last days**; because you will do evil in the sight of Yahweh, to provoke him to anger through the work of your hands. (Deuteronomy 31:29, this “evil” is the great tribulation of 66 - 70 AD, emphasis added)

The anger of Yahweh shall not return, until He has executed, and till He has performed the thoughts of His heart: in **the last days** you shall consider it perfectly. (Jeremiah 23:20, emphasis added)

The fierce anger of Yahweh shall not return, until he has done *it*, and until he has performed the intents of his heart: in **the last days** you shall consider it. (Jeremiah 30:24, emphasis added)

Yet will I bring again the captivity of Moab in **the last days**, says Yahweh. Thus far *is* the judgment of Moab. (Jeremiah 48:47, emphasis added)

But it shall come to pass in **the last days**, *that* I will bring again the captivity of Elam, says Yahweh. (Jeremiah 49:39, emphasis added)

And you shall come up against my people of Israel, as a cloud to cover the land; it shall be in **the last days**, and I will bring you against my land, that the gentiles may know me, when I shall be sanctified in thee, O Gog, before their eyes. (Ezekiel 38:16, emphasis added)

But there is a God in heaven that reveals secrets, and makes known to the king Nebuchadnezzar what shall be in **the last days**. Your dream, and the visions of your head upon your bed, are these; (Daniel 2:28, emphasis added)

Now I am come to make you understand what shall befall your people in **the last days**: for yet the vision *is* for *many* days. (Daniel 10:14, emphasis added)

Afterward shall the children of Israel return, and seek Yahweh their God, and David their king; and shall fear Yahweh and his goodness in **the last days**. (Hosea 3:5, emphasis added)
